

Dear Parent(s),

This letter confirms your student's registration for the first ever Granger Student Ministries High School Camp, June 28–July 1, 2021. This is going to be an incredible experience for your student as scores of high school students, guided by a group of incredible counselors, lean in to experience God and have an incredible time along the way! We are thrilled that your student will be joining us for this truly life-changing week!

To help you and your camper get ready for this new experience, we've included some details and information that will help you to prepare and know a bit more of what to expect:

- Each day will consist of sessions held at the Granger Campus as well as day trips throughout the greater Michiana region. These day trips will be memory-making adventures for campers and their counselors to experience together.
- Similar to past Granger Community Church (GCC) camp experiences, each camper will be placed in a group of peers and paired with a counselor throughout the week. Together this group will experience sessions, day trips and group time.
- High School Camp will be full days of amazing experiences with campers spending the nights at home. You should plan to drop off your camper at the Granger Campus each morning **at 9 a.m.** and to pick up your camper each evening **at 10 p.m.**
- Even though campers will sleep at home, High School Camp will be a continuous experience with each day building on the last so you should plan for your camper to fully be a part of all four days so they won't miss anything.
- Lunches and dinners will be covered each day as will all costs for the day trips including transportation. Each camper will also get a camp shirt as part of their registration.
- Any and all necessary precautions surrounding COVID-19 will be planned for as camp approaches and families will be made aware of those steps.
- As details are finalized for each of the day trips and greater clarity is gained on any COVID-19 protocols, we will send out a full itinerary prior to camp that will include any day trip waivers needed and guidance on any items your camper should pack for the day. You can expect this communication by the end of May.

We look forward to spending the week with your camper and can't wait to see all the ways that God is going to move through this new camp experience!
