### 1. Ronald McDonald House

**About Ronald McDonald House:** The Ronald McDonald house provides a home-away-from-home for families with seriously ill and injured children ages 21 and younger.

#### **Option #1 - Purchase and/or donate (any of the following items – must be new/unopened):**

- Macaroni and cheese
- Canned Soups
- Boxed Pasta Meals
- Chips
- Crackers
- Granola Bars
- Fruit Cups
- Single Serve Snacks (chips, trail mix, cookies, etc.)
- Shampoo
- Soap or Shower Gel
- Conditioner
- Deodorant
- Brush and/or Comb
- Razors
- Toothbrushes/Toothpaste

**Where to drop them off:** 610 N. Michigan Street, Suite 310, South Bend, IN 46601 / 574.647.3020

**When to drop them off:** Any day; Monday through Sunday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

**Option #2** - Provide a meal and/or cookies, snacks for families at the Ronald McDonald House. The food items can be made at home or purchased from a local restaurant, and dropped off.

**When to drop them off:** If you're providing a meal, you'll need to contact the Ronald McDonald house directly to set up a time. If you're dropping off snacks and/or cookies, they can be dropped off any day; Monday through Sunday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

### 2. Center for the Homeless (CFH)

**About the CFH:** The Center for the Homeless is South Bend's largest residential facility for individuals and families experiencing homelessness. The Center strives to break the cycle of homelessness for men, women, children and veterans.

#### **What to purchase and/or donate (any of the following items – must be new/unopened):**

- Diapers – size 4
- Pull-ups – size 6
- Wipes
- Bathing Suits – (New/all sizes)

- Children's Tylenol
- Ibuprofen
- Deodorant
- Men's and Women's Underwear (New)
- Toilet Bowl Cleaner
- Clorox Wipes
- Windex
- All Purpose Cleaner
- Clear Shower Curtains
- Paper Towels
- Lysol
- Kitchen Trash Bags
- Individual Hand Sanitizer
- Hats/Gloves
- Hand Warmers

**When to drop them off:** Any day; the location is open 24 hours a day. If it's between the hours of 9 p.m. and 7 a.m., please call the number above first (you'll want to speak to someone at the front desk).

### **3. Faith Mission**

**About Faith Mission:** Faith Mission of Elkhart, Inc. is a Christian social service agency which provides food, shelter, clothing and other services for homeless individuals.

**What to purchase and/or donate (any of the following items – must be new/unopened):**

- Medications (Benadryl, Tylenol, Advil, Aspirin, Cough Drops, Pepto, etc.)
- First Aid Supplies (Bactine, Triple Antibiotic ointment, Band-Aids, Lice treatments, Ace wraps, etc.)
- Kitchen Supplies (Styrofoam cups/bowls, paper towels, 55-gallon trash bags, etc.)
- Food Supplies (Coffee, sugar, noodles, canned fruit and orange juice/fruit juice)
- Personal Care Items (Deodorant, shampoo/conditioner, diapers, toothbrushes, etc.)

### **4. South Bend Community Re-Entry Center**

**About the Re-Entry Center:** The South Bend Community Re-Entry Center is a minimum-security work release center that houses approximately 175 men. Granger Community Church has partnered with this organization for over 10 years and strives to speak life, hope and encouragement to the men and staff. Many of the men don't have support from their families, so clothing is a huge blessing as they strive to be employed in the community.

**What to purchase and/or donate (any of the following items – some items must be new/others gently used – no sports teams attire allowed)**

- Men's Underwear – all sizes (must be new)

- Men's Socks – (must be new)
- Men's T-shirts, Sweatshirts, Hoodies, etc. – all sizes (new or gently used)
- Men's Jeans, Sweat Pants, Shorts, etc. – all sizes (new or gently used)
- Men's Jackets and Coats – all sizes (new or gently used)
- Men's Work Boots and Athletic Shoes – all sizes (new or gently used)
- Men's Belts – all sizes (new or gently used)

***\*Dress clothes and suits are not needed.***
