Currently services include layettes, winter clothing for children, clothing and other items for children entering foster care, and a number of educational services.

What to purchase and/or donate (any of the following items):

- Gently used children's clothing, boots and athletic shoes
- Children's books
- Good as new (or new) stuffed animals
- Shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste and body wash.
- Coloring books (adult and children)
- Toys and educational items for foster children.
