

Kids' Baptism Basics

How do I register for Baptism?

- Attend a Baptism Orientation
- We want to hear everyone's testimony—your special story of how you met and decided to follow Jesus, and what your life is like now. There are two ways you can turn in your testimony to us by May 20:
 - Bring your testimony to Guest Services at the campus you attend.
 - Email your testimony to kids@grangerchurch.com.

Include with your testimony the campus and service time you wish to be baptized. Registration will be facilitated by Granger Community Church staff and a confirmation will be emailed to you.

What do I wear?

- Wear a black shirt—no graphics and no writing, no tank tops or tank t's.
- Wear your baptism clothes to the service. You will not have an opportunity to change.
- Bring a towel or two. You may want one towel available for you in the auditorium immediately after your baptism and another towel to use during changing.
- You may want to wear flip-flops or rubber-soled shoes for support in the pool.
- Changing areas will be provided after your baptism.

What is the schedule?

- Check in at the designated Baptism check-in area when you arrive at church.
- Put your name tag high on your right shoulder.
- Turn in your testimony if you have not yet submitted it.
- Leave your bag with your change of clothes and towels at the check-in area.
- Be sure to keep one towel with you.
- Attend the service. You will be instructed during service when it is time to line up.
- Attendants will be available in the auditorium to guide you to a pool and escort you to the changing areas.

COVID-19 Protocols

- Please bring a mask to wear.
- We will be sure to social distance while in line waiting for pools.
- Hand sanitizer will be available before entering the pool.
- Masks are optional in the pool as those who will be doing the baptizing will have masks on.
