## VOLUNTEER LEADER COVENANT

### CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP

I believe that every Granger Community Church volunteer leader is entrusted by the church to influence and shepherd others and is a "leader" in the eyes of those participating in the life of the church. Therefore, as a leader in this church body, I am called to live a life pursuing what is good (Titus 1:6-9 and 1 Timothy 3:1-13). I understand that I am putting myself on a platform by accepting this leadership role, and as a result, many participants will judge the church, as well as Jesus, by what they see me do. This doesn't mean that I can never mess up, because only Jesus pulled that off. However, when my leadership integrity is compromised, there will be temporary or permanent consequences that are determined by a pastor and a member of the Executive Team. I understand that I am held to a higher standard because I am being entrusted to help people take their next steps toward Christ...together, and I don't take that responsibility lightly.

I'm ready to become a Granger Community Church volunteer leader and I agree to uphold the following Christian leadership values:

**COMMITMENT:** A Christian leader should have a firm commitment, not only to the team and the vision, but commitment to their faith. You should also have knowledge of the love of the Savior that goes farther than just the head; knowledge that goes to the heart and is put into action through loving others. True commitment is a passion to live life with God and bring His Kingdom down here to earth, all for the glory of Jesus Christ.

**CONVICTION:** A Christian leader's identity and passions must be shaped by what the Bible says. What do you base your life convictions on? Is it on what others view as important, or is it on what the Bible says? Motivated by a Christian worldview, you should be actively pursuing transformation by the renewal of your mind (Romans 12:2) in every area of your life.

**COMPETENCY:** A Christian leader should be biblically competent and have abundant evidence of the Holy Spirit working in his or her life. You should know the Bible well enough to help guide others through a better understanding of the Scriptures. You should also have identifiable spiritual gifts that are used to encourage others and edify the Church.

**CHARACTER:** A Christian leader must possess good character. Your character is of the utmost importance because this is what other people see. They don't see your heart or what you are thinking, they can only see how your faith is demonstrated by your actions. Follow Titus 1:6-9 and 1 Timothy 3:1-13 for more specifics on the character of a good Christian leader.

*"Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care, watching over them, not because you must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be; not pursuing dishonest gain, but eager to serve, not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock."* —1 Peter 5:2-3
